**Rapid testing is administered on a voluntary basis with the goal of ensuring that port operations can continue in a safe environment.**

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***Rapid tests will be administered only to those individuals who are asymptomatic.***

***If you are symptomatic, do not enter the premises - Seek medical advice from Public Health***

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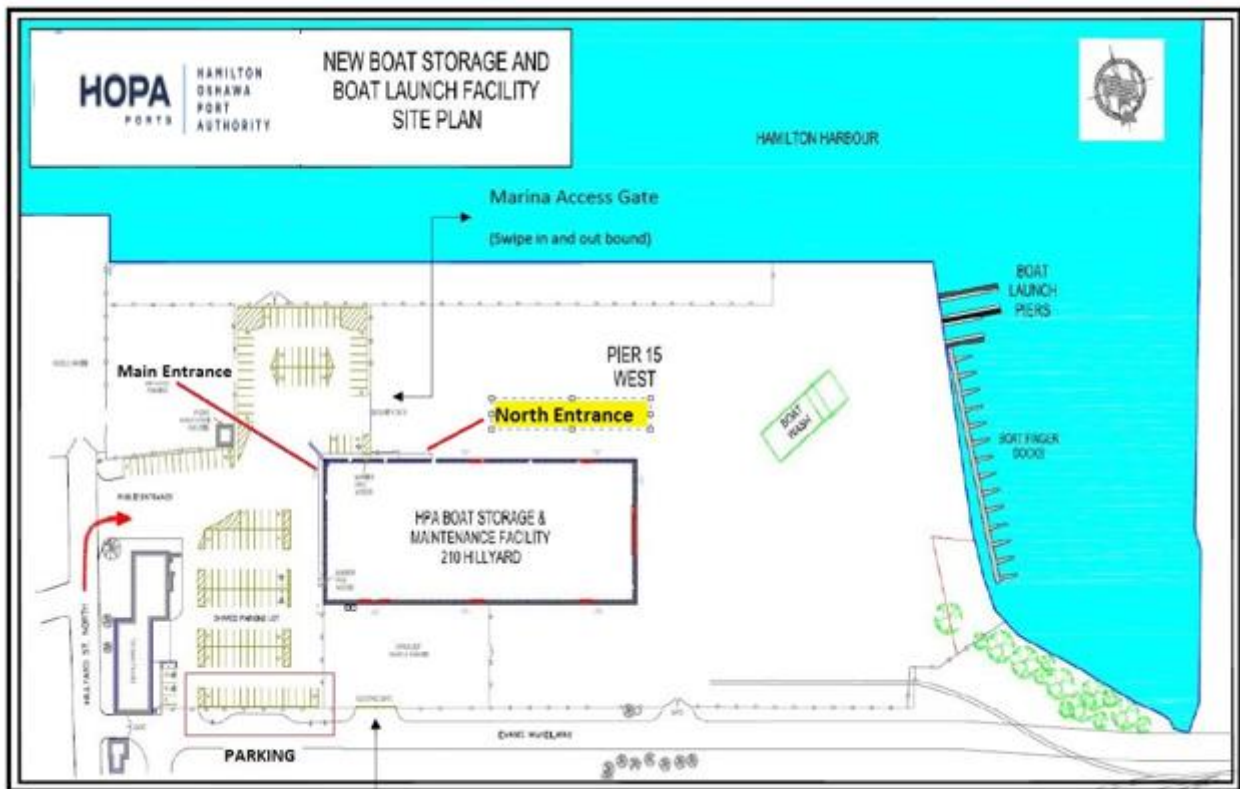
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## Location of Testing Site

Testing will take place at HOPA Ports Marina and Maintenance Facility located at 210 Hillyard Street - 2<sup>nd</sup> floor, Hamilton ON.

- Parking is available on site at the north or west side of the building
- On arrival, please enter through the “North Entrance” door (as indicated on map in yellow)

## How is the test administered?

The Abbott Panbio test is conducted through a nasopharyngeal swab.

Once the specimen is processed, results are available within 15 minutes.

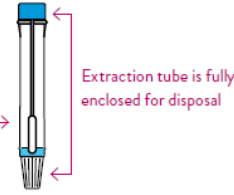

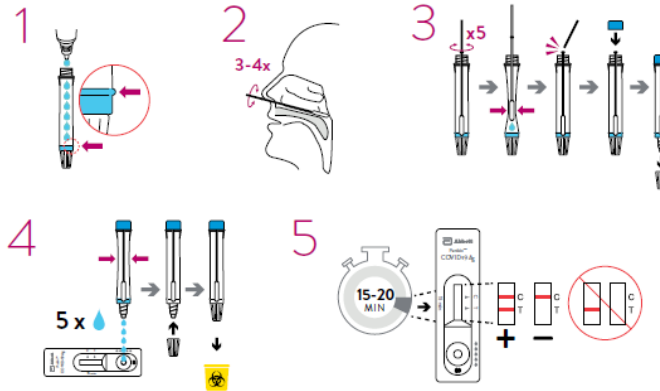

The test provides preliminary test results. Negative results don't preclude SARS-CoV-2 infection and they cannot be used as the sole basis for treatment or other management decisions. Negative results must be combined with clinical observations, patient history, and epidemiological information. The test is not intended to be used as a donor screening test for SARS-CoV-2.

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## What to expect on the day of your test

1. Prior to entering, ensure that you have complete your COVID-19 Screening Questionnaire (Annex A).
2. When you arrive at 210 Hillyard St., you will enter the north door wearing a mask (PPE) and proceed up the stairwell to the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor. Please remember to maintain physical distancing – 2 meters between each person.
3. At the door, you will provide the Administrator with a copy of your completed COVID-19 Screening Questionnaire.
4. You will be instructed to proceed to 1 out of 8 Rapid Testing stations.
5. The Health Care Professional will ask you various questions including name and employer before administering the nasopharyngeal test.
6. Once the test has been administered, it will be processed. You must remain at your assigned station until results are available. This should take approximately 15 minutes.
7. Once the results have been confirmed, you will be advised if your test is negative, positive or inconclusive.
  - **Negative result:** You will be permitted to resume work duties.
  - **Positive result:** You will be instructed to self isolate and follow up with a laboratory-based PCR test. This will act as a confirmatory test within 24 hours. Contact your employer.
  - **Inconclusive result:** The rapid test will be re-administered on site.
8. Once complete, you are to proceed out of the building, remembering to maintain physical distancing – 2 meters between each person upon departure.

Testing locations will be sanitized after each use.



Room Set Up Illustration:

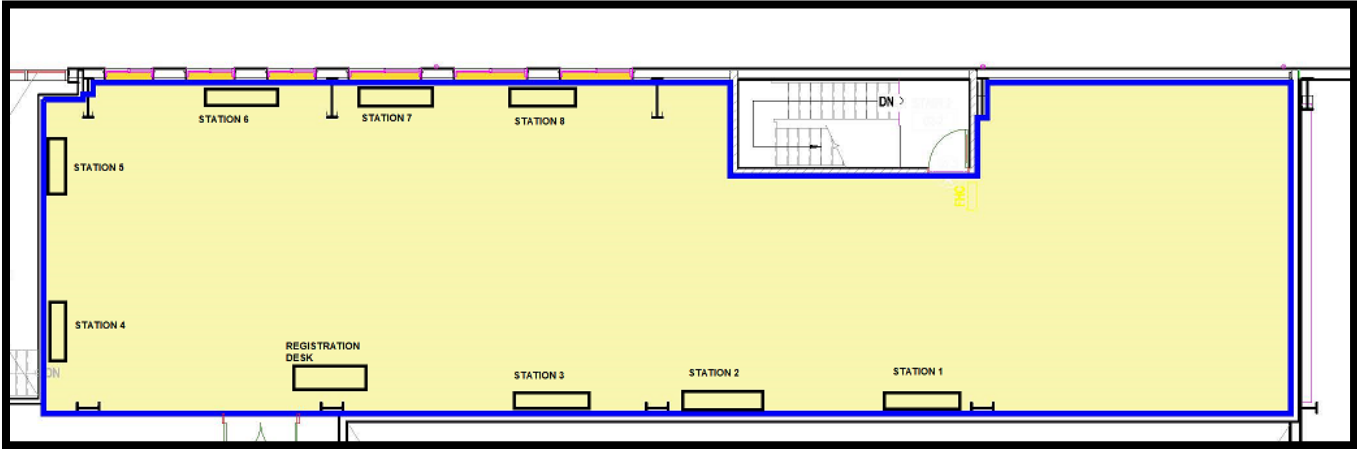
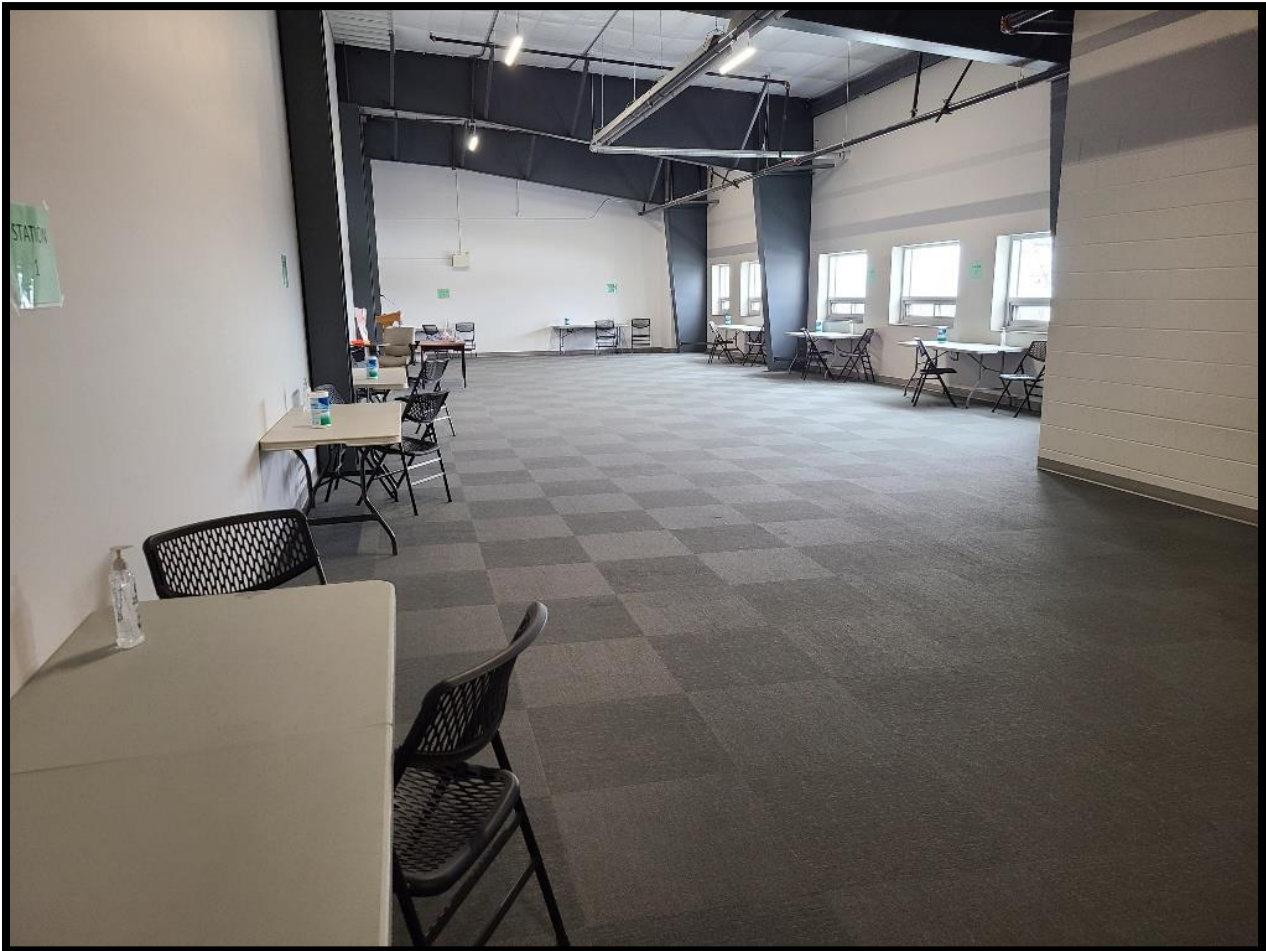
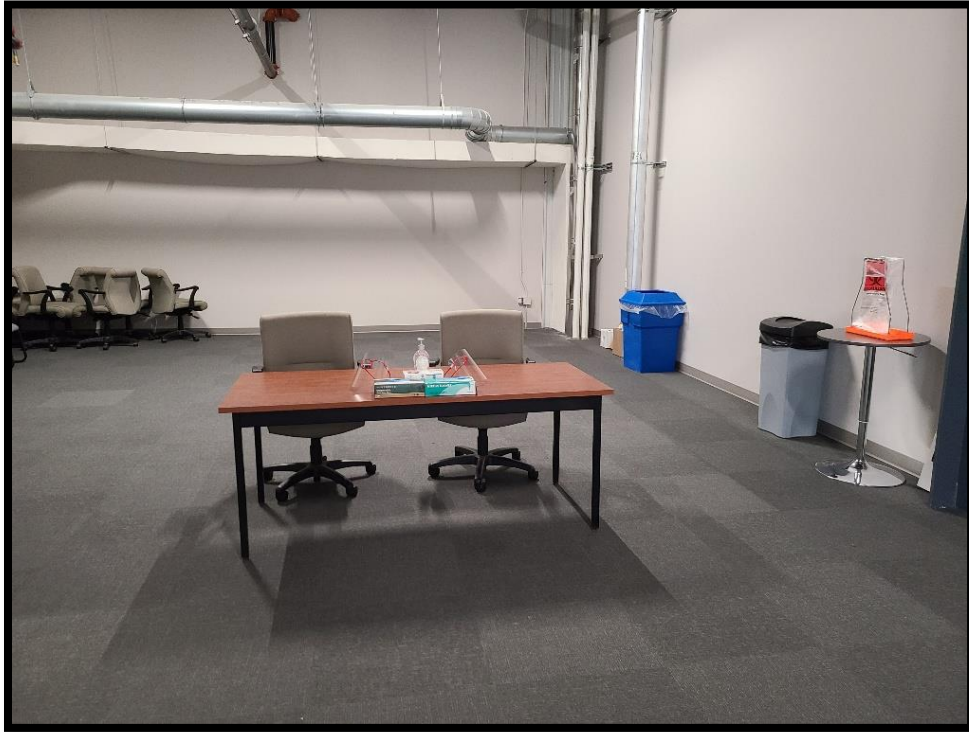


Photo of actual location of Rapid Testing Stations:

### Results of Screening Questions:

- If the individual answers **NO to all questions from 1 through 3**, they have passed and can enter the workplace.
- If the individual answers **YES to any questions from 1 through 3**, they have not passed and **should be advised that they should not** enter the workplace (including any outdoor, or partially outdoor, workplaces). They should go home to self-isolate immediately and contact their health care provider or Telehealth Ontario (1 866-797-0000) to find out if they need a COVID-19 test.
