Subject: Prevention measures taken by the maritime line OOCL relating to COVID-19

The objective of this announcement is to inform you of the measures taken by the maritime line OOCL as of March 22nd in order to protect their navigating employees from COVID-19.

It is important to note that these measures aim at protecting OOCL personnel as well as employees accessing the ship.

1. Anyone wishing to access the accommodations on OOCL ships will have to submit to a temperature verification using an infrared contactless thermometer.
2. For their protection, the ship's crew will wear masks during their interactions with all visitors.
3. The crews onboard ships arriving at the Port of Montréal as of March 22nd are not allowed to disembark. This instruction is valid since March 1st and has been applied in all their stopovers.
4. The sailors will respect social distancing with visitors coming onboard.
5. The ship's officers will continue to fill-out the documents concerning the crew's health, as required by Transport Canada procedures.
