Decision emitted by the CIRB today

On October 23, 2018, the MEA presented a demand for maintaining essential activities in accordance with the requirements of the Canada Labour Code. The demand aimed at maintaining the longshoring activities in the event of a strike from the Union at the port of Montréal.

We have reviewed the decision. Although it does not correspond to our expectations, we remain convinced that the continuity and stability of the logistics chain is of the utmost importance.

We are evaluating different options.
