**CIRCULAR LETTER NO. 2143**

**To: All Members of the Maritime Employers Association**

**Subject: MEA Assessment Rates and Tariffs – Port of Montréal**

---

**The Board of Directors has reviewed the Association's 2021 funding requirements for its Port of Montréal's linesmen operations.**

The Board of Directors has agreed that the linesmen service rates be adjusted in 2021. Effective January 1, 2021, the linesmen service tariffs will be increased by \$176.00 per movement for ocean vessels and by \$90.00 per movement for coastal vessels. Furthermore, the Board of Directors also agreed to increase the linesmen's service rate for passenger vessels by 9 %.

This will confirm that tariffs for the MEA linesmen service, as of January 1, 2021, are as follows:

<b>Ocean vessels:</b>	<b>\$ 2,132 per movement</b>
<b>Passenger vessels:</b>	<b>\$ 2,785 per movement</b>
<b>Coastal vessels: (125 meters or less)</b>	<b>\$ 1,087 per movement</b>

These tariffs apply to all vessels that are subject to the terms and conditions under the collective agreement signed with Montréal Local 375, Longshoremen, including those vessels utilizing Article 22.02 (standby gangs) of the agreement.

This Circular Letter amends the linesmen service tariffs as detailed in Circular Letter No. 2126 dated January 16, 2020.
